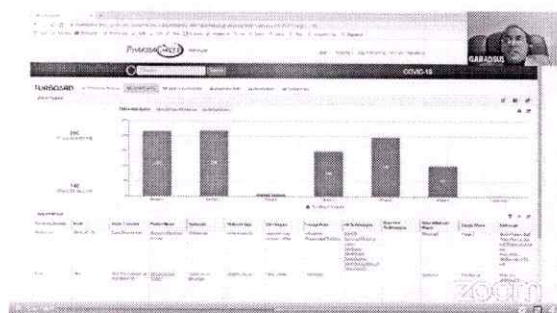
- Spike (S) protein binds to the cellular receptor ACE2 and the S2P virus cleavage is facilitated by endosomes.

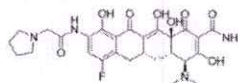

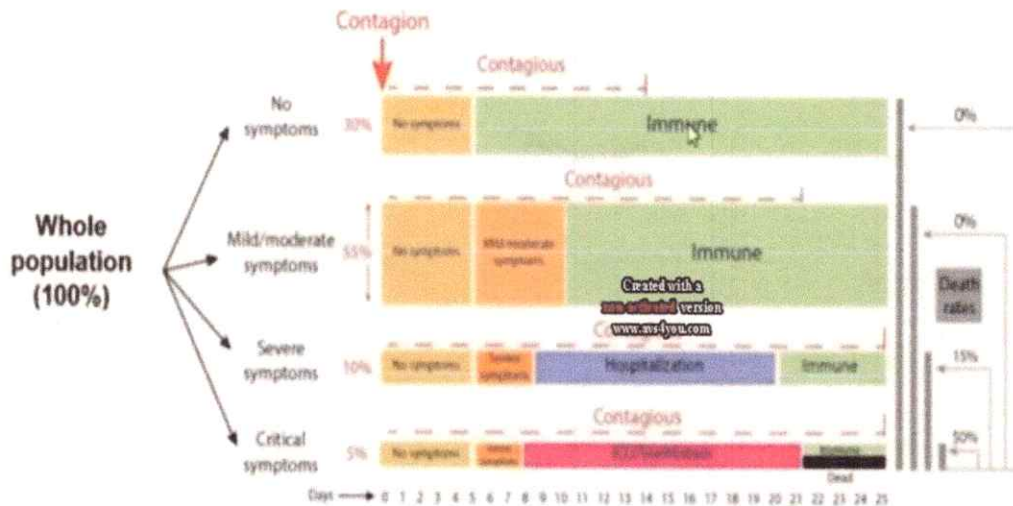

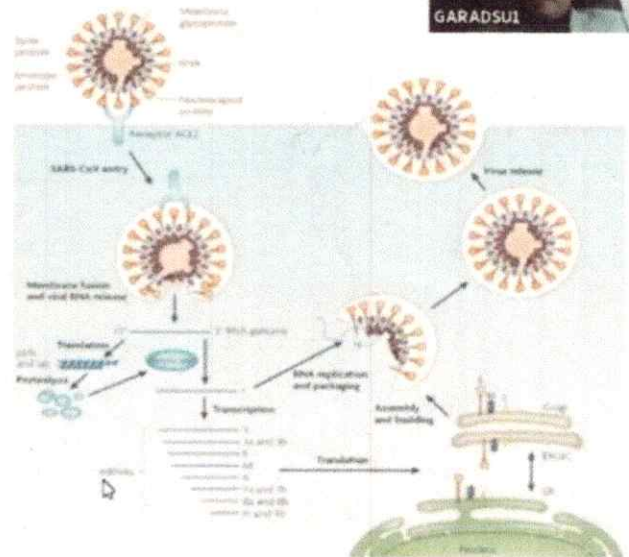
Spectrum of COVID19 disease clinical presentation

SARS-CoV replication in host cells

- Spike (S) protein first binds to the cellular receptor ACE2 and the ACE2-virus complex is translocated to endosomes
- The viral genome is released and translated into viral replicase polyproteins pp1a and 1ab, which are then cleaved into small products by viral proteinases.
- The full-length negative-strand template is made as a template for genomic RNA
- Viral nucleocapsids are assembled from genomic RNA and N protein in the cytoplasm, followed by budding into the lumen of the ERGIC
- Virions are then released from the cell through exocytosis
