1. Rules for Carrom Competition

- Entries are welcome for carrom singles and doubles for both students and faculty.
- Entry fees: 100/- per candidate(students) & 200/- per candidate (faculty)
- Rules and Regulation –
- 1. Original identity proof (college ID and Aadhar card/Driving License/Voter ID)
- 2. Umpire decision is the last decision and irrevocable.
- 3. All rights are reserved to the organizers.
- 4. All players must be present on given timings; late comers will not be going to be entertain.
- 5. All matches are going to be knockouts.
- **6.** Location- DBCOP Campus

Here are the fundamental, must-know rules of a carrom:

- Toss will carry out between two teams, the team who win the toss will get striker first and decision to play.
- > Thumb is not allowed.
- ➤ 3sets will be taken out of which 2 will be considered with maximum points.
- Maximum time limit is 15 mins, those who secure maximum point will be the winner.
- ➤ Board Setup: The carrom board is set up with the queen at the centre and the players' pieces arranged in a specific pattern.
- Striking: Players take turns to strike the striker, aiming to pocket their own color of carrom men and the queen.
- Fouls: Fouls include potting the striker, pocketing the opponent's carrom men, or not pocketing any carrom men in successive turns.
- Pocketing: The player pocketing the queen must also pocket one of their carron men in the same turn to be entitled to score.
- ➤ Queen Cover: Before pocketing the queen, a player must ensure that at least one of their carrom men is covered by the queen.
- Final match will be of 24 points.

2. Rules for Chess Competition

Here are the fundamental, must-know rules of a volleyball game:

- Only 6 players on the floor at any given time: 3 in the front row and 3 in the back row.
- Points are made on every serve for the winning team of the rally (rally-point scoring).
- Players may not hit the ball twice in succession (a block is not considered a hit).
- Ball may be played off the net during a volley and on a serve.
- A ball hitting a boundary line is in.
- A ball is out if it hits an antennae, the floor completely outside the court, any of the net or cables outside the antennae, the referee stand or pole, or the ceiling above a non-playable area.
- It is legal to contact the ball with any part of a player's body.
- It is illegal to catch, hold or throw the ball.
- A player cannot block or attack a serve from on or inside the 10-foot line.
- After the serve, front-line players may switch positions at the net.
- Matches are made up of sets; the number depends on level of play.



- Maximum duration of performance must be 10 min. Negative marking on exceeding the time limit.
- Each institute can depute only one team of maximum 15 members.
- Performance can be any of any Genre provided it should not be provocative or vulgar.
- Performance or music should not include foul language, should not hamper any religious sentiments and should not create any political unrest. Any performance containing above elements will be disqualified on the spot.
- Music track should be provided in advance at the time of registration to the technical team. The participating team should also carry their audio track in a pendrive.
- The performance slot will be displayed a day prior to the competition. Failure to report on time will be subjected to elimination.
- Judge's decision will be final and irrevocable.

6. Rules for Drama/ Mime Competition

- The Drama & Mime Competition serves as a platform for students and teachers to promote and demonstrate creative ideas in their work. It is hoped that the theme can instill values among students to be more sensitive and appreciative towards local arts.
- This competition is open to all pharmacy students (degree and diploma) from approved institutes.
- Each team comprises a minimum of 1 & maximum of 15 participants, including the technical crew: stage manager, technical coordinator, set and prop assistant, and prompter
- A minimum of 4 members of the team should participate and speak from group.
- All team members must be from the same college.
- The duration of the stage performance is limited to 10 to 15 minutes.
- Participating teams are encouraged to produce their own scripts. Scripts or translated scripts of established plays must be adapted. They should not be contradictory to any copyrighted work
- Participants should wear appropriate and decent costumes that suit the characters they portray.
- Performance can be of any genre, provided it is not provocative or vulgar.

Set and Props:

- Stage Dimensions- 32 x 24 ft. The entrance will be from the stairs only; no ramp will be provided.
- Minimize the use of sets and props. All equipment and its operation are the responsibility of every participating team.
- Sets and props should not hinder the movement of team members on stage.
- The use of sharp objects (such as knives, keris, etc.), fire, inflammable materials, and dangerous chemical substances is strictly prohibited.
- Each team is responsible for setting up (5 minutes) and clearing sets and props (5 minutes). Only the 15 participants are allowed on or behind the stage throughout the drama.
- Each team should have technical assistants only from the team members to coordinate music and recordings.
- All equipment and its operation are the responsibility of every participating team.
- Participants can use their own additional equipment. However, the equipment used must be suitable for the stage and should not disrupt the flow of the drama presentation.
- The judge's decision will be final and irrevocable.

- 2) Judges' decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
- 3) Criteria for judging include content, delivery, teamwork, and overall persuasiveness.

- 2) Exceeding time limits may lead to point deductions.
